

# Acceptable Forms of Identification for 1583

“CMRAs and their customers must present two forms of identification, one with a photograph. Social Security cards, credit cards, and birth certificates are not acceptable forms of identification. Following are examples of acceptable forms of identification:

- Valid driver’s license or non-driver’s license state ID
- Armed forces ID
- Government ID
- University ID
- Recognized corporate ID
- Passport
- Alien registration card
- Current lease, mortgage or deed
- Voter registration card
- Utility bill
- Home or vehicle insurance policy
- Vehicle registration card

The identification presented must confirm that the applicant is who he or she claims to be. By verifying identification, the Postal Service will protect against delivering mail without verifiable consent of the actual addressee.”
